While **Large Language Models (LLMs)** hold transformative potential for healthcare, their development is hindered by strict data regulations, a lack of clinical specialization, especially in non-English settings, and the safety risks inherent in non-deterministic AI. Bridging these gaps requires absolute clinical precision and the establishment of standardized benchmarks to ensure patient safety.

This Conference aims to:

- **Present recent research and findings on LLMs in healthcare**, with a particular focus on open-source and collaborative approaches.
- **Foster discussion & collaboration** on the major regulatory, scientific, technical and ethical challenges associated with LLMs in healthcare.
- **Open a dialogue with industry stakeholders** to compare research findings with real-world applications, limitations, and the conditions for deployment.
